SUNDAY WORSHIP OPTIONS AND PROCEDURES

- 1. No member of St. Stephen's, especially those who are at heightened risk of infection, should feel pressured to either help lead or attend in-person worship. We recognize some members are not yet comfortable returning to in-person worship. We encourage those most at risk, those not comfortable worshipping in person, and those who are homebound to continue to participate in our Digital (On-Line) Service of Holy Eucharist with Spiritual Communion at 9:15 am on our Friends of St. Stephen's Facebook page. The Worship Order for this service will be sent by email no later than Saturday at 6:00 pm to all on our email list.
- At 7:15 am we will have an In-person Service of Holy Eucharist in the Memorial Garden that will last no more than 45 minutes. The Worship Order for this service will be sent by email no later than Saturday at 6:00 pm to all on our email list. EVERYONE WISHING TO ATTEND THIS SERVICE MUST:
 - MAKE RESERVATION FOR EACH SUNDAY'S 7:15 AM WORSHIP by calling and leaving a
 message at the Church Office (951-845-1358) between the hours of 8:00 am on
 Thursday and 12:00 Noon on Friday. The phone message must say who is calling, who
 (if anyone) else is coming with the caller, and a return number in case we need to return
 the call. We require reservations so that we can make necessary preparations.
 - WHEN ATTENDING THE 7:15 AM SUNDAY WORSHIP YOU MUST:
 - Have your temperature checked before entering worship. If your temperature is 100.4° or higher, we will respectfully require that you leave and seek medical care as appropriate.
 - Wear a mask over your nose and mouth if you are two years or older. If you are unable to wear a mask you should consider attending on-line services instead of coming to the church campus.
 - Use hand sanitizer
 - Keep 6-foot distancing
 - DO NOT COME TO THE CHURCH FOR THE 7:15 AM SUNDAY WORSHP:
 - \circ If you or a contact have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days;
 - If you have traveled overnight or been around someone who traveled overnight in the last five days, if that travel involved attending public gatherings or overnight lodging;
 - If in the past 72 hours you have experienced fever (temperature greater than 100.3°F), new onset cough, new loss of taste or smell, new onset muscle or body aches, GI upset (diarrhea or vomiting).

IF YOUR ANSWER IS "YES" TO ANY OF THE QUESTIONS SHOWN ABOVE WE RESPECTFULLY REQUIRE THAT YOU <u>REMAIN HOME</u> AND CONSIDER ATTENDING ON-LINE WORSHIP INSTEAD OF COMING TO CHURCH.

IF YOU COME TO CHURCH AND ANSWER "YES" TO ANY OF THE QUESTIONS SHOWN ABOVE WHEN WE ASK THEM OF YOU BEFORE ENTERING, WE RESPECTFULLY REQUIRE THAT YOU RETURN HOME AND RECOMMEND YOU CONTACT YOUR PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER TO DISCUSS COVID-19 TESTING.

- 3. At 9:15 am, we will continue to have our digital Sunday service of Holy Eucharist with Spiritual Communion on our Friends of St. Stephen's Facebook page. This will be a permanent offering.
- 4. From 10:30 am to 12:00 Noon, we will offer Drive Through Communion from the Reserved Sacrament. The Communion offered will have been blessed at our 7:15 am Holy Eucharist service. Our hope is that people who drive through to receive the Sacrament will have participated in the 9:15 am digital service, but we realize that may not be possible for everyone. A brief prayer and scripture will be offered from the "Communion under Special Circumstances" rite which begins at page 396 of The Book of Common Prayer. People wishing to receive the Sacrament should drive to the Edgar Avenue side of the church where you will receive further instruction.
